

#### Tuition and Fees Cost

#### SAIC Merit Scholarships

- No additional application is required; merit scholarships are awarded at the time of admission based on a holistic view of your portfolio and application materials.

#### What is the FAFSA?

- It is the <u>free</u> Federal Application that student's need to submit each year to be eligible for Federal Financial Aid.
- To apply for federal student aid, such as need based work-study eligibility and federal loans, you need to complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
- In addition, many colleges like SAIC, use your FAFSA information to determine your eligibility for need based institutional financial assistance.





#### Submit the FAFSA?

- ► Student's must submit a FAFSA each academic year in which Financial Aid is sought.
- Students must be a U.S. citizen or eligible noncitizen -- International Students do not submit a FAFSA.
- Students, in accordance with Federal Student Aid, must also include their spouses information on their FAFSA Application as a "Contributor".
- ▶ The 2025-26 FAFSA became available to complete December 1, 2024.

### Secure an FSA ID before submitting your FAFSA

- Students and Contributors will not be able to access the FAFSA form without an FSA ID set up prior to starting the form.
- An FSA ID is a username and password you need to access Federal Student Aid Applications.
- Remember, the FSA ID is unique and the student and contributor (if applicable) have their very own. Do not mix them up.
- Please be sure to remember your FSA ID; you will need it again in the future. Write it down in a secure place.

#### What happens next?

- ► The student will receive a email from Federal Student Aid within 3 days after the FAFSA is submitted.
- READ that email.
- ➤ Your FAFSA information is shared with the colleges you list on the application. (up to 20 colleges can be added)
- Schools uses your information to determine how much aid you may receive at that individual school.
- ▶ Other schools might also have other forms for you to fill out
- ▶ The FAFSA is the only Financial Aid Form needed at SAIC.



#### What is the result of the FAFSA?

- ► If your FAFSA is complete, the student will be notified of the results of the FAFSA Student Aid Index (SAI)
- Schools use the SAI to determine your federal student aid eligibility and Financial Aid Award Offer.
- ➤ Your SAI is **not** the amount of money you will have to pay for college, **nor** is it the amount of federal student aid you will receive. It is the number used by Federal Student Aid and your school to calculate the amount of aid you are eligible to receive.



#### Financial Aid Award Offer

- Once SAIC receives your SAI from your submitted FAFSA, we will use it to determine your eligibility
  for Financial Assistance and provide you with a Financial Aid Award Offer.
- ▶ Your Financial Aid Award Offer <u>may contain</u>:
  - Scholarships and Grants (free money)
    - Merit Scholarships from SAIC (Department)
    - ▶ Need Based Grants
  - Federal Work-Study Eligibility (earned money)
    - Federal Need Based Self-Help based on (SAI)
  - Federal Student Loans (must be paid back)
    - ► Federal Direct Unsubsidized Stafford Loans
    - ▶ Eligibility for <u>credit-based</u> Federal Direct Graduate PLUS Loans
  - ► Eligibility for Private Loans (must be payed back)
    - ▶ If you choose not to access Federal Direct Graduate PLUS Loans. Also <u>credit based</u>.


SAIC will start providing
