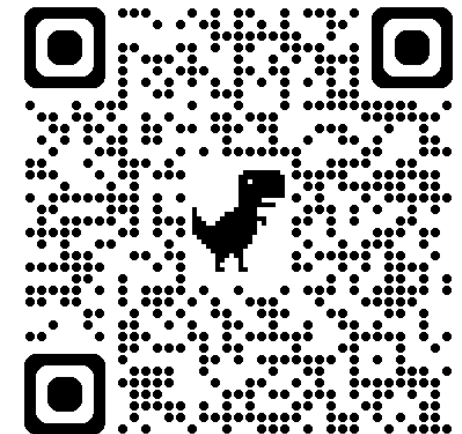

Tuition and Fees Cost

- ▶ The cost of an education at the School of the Art Institute of Chicago includes more than just tuition

SAIC Merit Scholarships

- ▶ SAIC awards generous **Merit Scholarships** to **Graduate students** who demonstrate exceptional levels of thoughtfulness, skill, conceptual capabilities, and academic groundedness.
- ▶ Scholarships are financial awards that **do not need to be repaid**.
- ▶ No additional application is required; merit scholarships are **awarded at the time of admission** based on a holistic view of your **portfolio and application materials**.

What is the FAFSA?

- ▶ It is the free **Federal Application** that student's need to submit each year to be eligible for Federal Financial Aid.
- ▶ To apply for federal student aid, such as need based work-study eligibility and federal loans, you need to complete the **Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)**.
- ▶ In addition, many colleges like SAIC, use your FAFSA information to determine your eligibility for **need based institutional financial assistance**.



Submit the FAFSA?

- ▶ Student's must **submit a FAFSA each academic year** in which Financial Aid is sought.
- ▶ Students must be a **U.S. citizen** or **eligible noncitizen** -- International Students **do not** submit a FAFSA.
- ▶ Students, in accordance with Federal Student Aid, **must also include their spouses information** on their FAFSA Application as a "**Contributor**".
- ▶ The **2026-27 FAFSA** became available to complete **October 1, 2025**.
- ▶ Available on-line at **StudentAid.gov**
- ▶ SAIC School code - **001753**

Secure an FSA ID before submitting your FAFSA

- ▶ Students and Contributors **will not be able to access** the FAFSA form **without an FSA ID** set up prior to starting the form.
- ▶ An **FSA ID** is a **username and password** you need to access Federal Student Aid Applications.
- ▶ Remember, the **FSA ID is unique** and the **student and contributor (if applicable)** have their very own. **Do not mix them up.**
- ▶ Please be sure to remember your FSA ID; you will need it again in the future. **Write it down in a secure place.**

What happens next?

- ▶ The student will receive a **email** from Federal Student Aid **within 3 days** after the FAFSA is submitted.
- ▶ **READ** that email.
- ▶ Your FAFSA information is **shared with the colleges** you list on the application. (up to 20 colleges can be added)
- ▶ Schools use your information to determine how much aid you may receive at that individual school.
- ▶ Other schools might also have **other forms** for you to fill out
- ▶ The **FAFSA is the only** Financial Aid Form **needed** to initially apply for need-based aid at SAIC.

What is the result of the FAFSA?

- ▶ If your FAFSA is complete, the student will be notified of the results of the FAFSA – **Student Aid Index (SAI)**
- ▶ Schools use the **SAI** to determine your federal student aid eligibility and Financial Aid Award Offer.
- ▶ Your SAI is **not** the amount of money you will have to pay for college, **nor** is it the amount of federal student aid you will receive. It is the number used by Federal Student Aid and your school to calculate the amount of aid you are eligible to receive.

Financial Aid Award Offer

- ▶ Once SAIC receives your SAI from your submitted FAFSA, we will use it to determine your eligibility for Financial Assistance and provide you with a **Financial Aid Award Offer**.
- ▶ Your Financial Aid Award Offer may contain:
 - ▶ **Scholarships and Grants** (*free money*)
 - ▶ Merit Scholarships from SAIC (Department)
 - ▶ Need Based Grants
 - ▶ **Federal Work-Study Eligibility** (*earned money*)
 - ▶ Federal Need Based Self-Help – based on (SAI)
 - ▶ **Federal Student Loans** (*must be paid back*)
 - ▶ Federal Direct Unsubsidized Stafford Loans
 - ▶ **Eligibility for Private Loans** (*must be payed back*)
 - ▶ Choose a Private Lender of your choice. (Credit Based)

When do students receive their SAIC Financial Aid Offer?

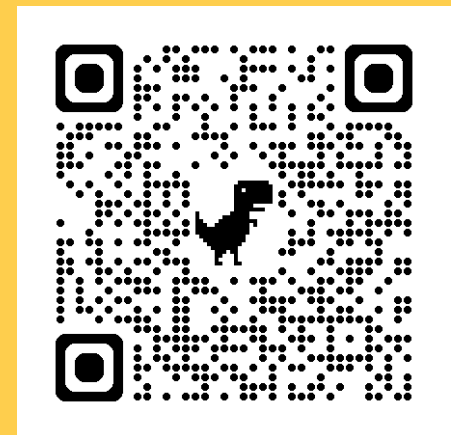
- SAIC will begin awarding New Graduate students who have submitted a 2026-27 FAFSA for **beginning in Mid-February, 2026.**
- **After** the student has been **admitted to SAIC** and we have **received your FAFSA**

How will I receive notification of my SAIC Financial Aid Award Offer?

- **Email:** An email will be sent informing students (**SAIC and Personal email**) that they have been awarded financial aid and that the award offer can be reviewed on the student's **Self-Service portal.**
- **Mail:** A financial aid award offer packet will be mailed to the **home mailing address** in a plain **[Big Blue Envelope](#).**

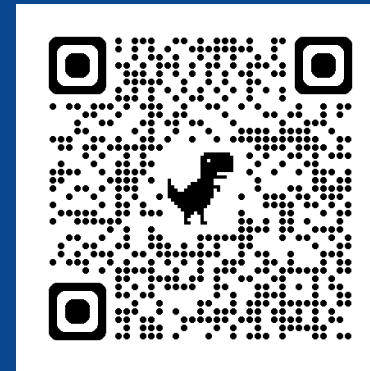
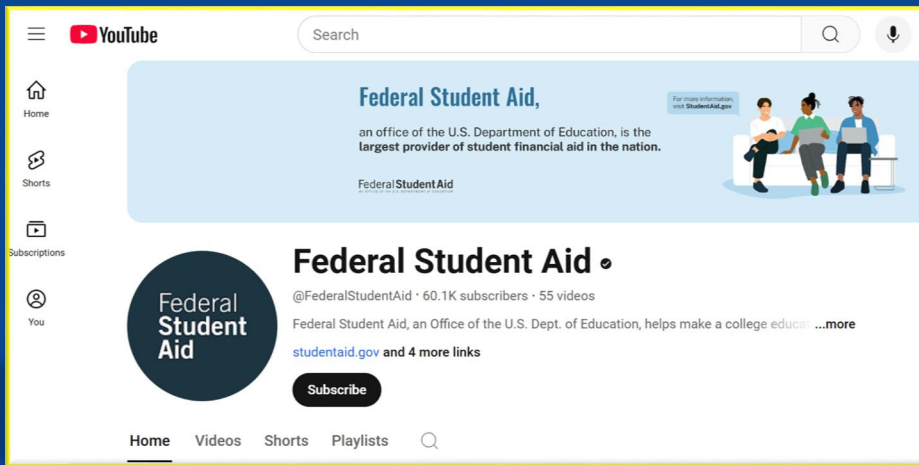
What do I do if I need help understanding my cost and Financial Aid?

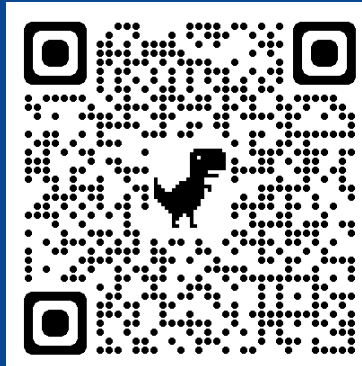

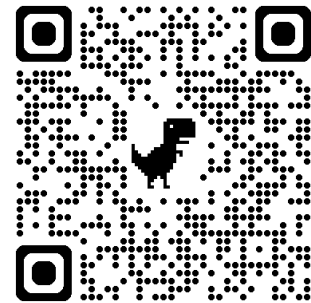
