# CURATED GUIDED TOURS OF MUSEUM

## **RAQIB SHAW: PARADISE LOST** (Gallery 141-142)

At the Art Institute, Shaw debuts his more-than 100-foot-wide, 21-panel *Paradise Lost* (2009–25), the artist’s most ambitious and personal project to date. Epic and intricate, monumental and meticulous—the paintings of Kashmir-raised, London-based artist Raqib Shaw offer fantastical meditations on identity, transformation, and the redemptive power of beauty.

## **THE THORNE MINIATURE ROOMS** (Gallery 11)

First created by Narcissa Niblack to raise funds for charities that helped nurses and children, each eye-level box-sized room represents an idealized historic interior, and the stunningly convincing lighting invites an immersive experience. Find mini suits of armor in the English Great Hall, a solid gold toy train in the “Middletown” Parlor, a serving tray made from a penny in the Cape Cod Living Room, and a host of miniature modern masterpieces in the California Hallway.
